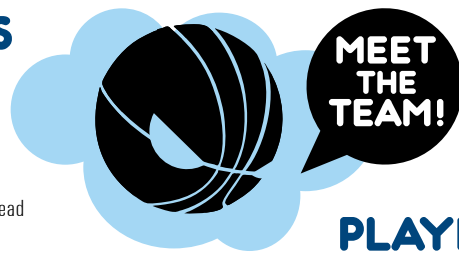

LANE SCHUMACHER Head Coach

Lane Schumacher enters his sixth season as CBC's Head Basketball Coach. This past season, Schumacher led CBC to the NWAACC Championship Tournament where the Hawks brought home the fourth place trophy. The 2006-07 Hawks finished 24-7 on the season and 3-1 at the NWAACC Tournament where they lost a heartbreaker to Bellevue CC in the semi-finals. Over the past few years, Schumacher has worked hard to reestablish a program that was once an NWAACC Championship contender. He has an overall record of 68-70 over the past five seasons including two

NWAACC Tournament appearances.

During Schumacher's six year tenure at CBC, 12 players have gone on to play at quality four year universities.

Schumacher, 36, is a local talent who grew up in Kennewick where he played for his father Don Schumacher at Kamiakin High School. He also played for former CBC Coach Ed Weidenbach during the 1988-89 season earning All Eastern Region honors. After one season as a Hawk, Schumacher left CBC to play at Gonzaga University for two seasons. He finished his college career at Northwest Nazarene University where he was named All Little Northwest First Team and Honorable Mention All-American.

After his playing career, Coach Schumacher served as the Head Coach at Nampa High School in Nampa, Idaho for three years. In his first season, he led his team to the school's first state tournament appearance in ten years, finishing fourth overall.

"My goal is to get this program back to where it should be, an NWAACC Championship contender," he said. "I expect our guys to play hard every time they step on the court. I want to see our guys get up and down the court and play high percentage basketball."

Schumacher also serves as the Academic Advisor for CBC's student-athletes. He helps students maintain a directed academic track ensuring they are getting all the help necessary to reach their goals.

Lane and his wife Lisa have been married for ten years and have a six-year-old daughter, Regan and are expecting another child this spring.

Coach Todd Schumacher enters his fifth season at CBC as the programs Head Recruiter and Bench Coach.

Schumacher coached at Meridian High School in Boise, Idaho for three years before moving back to the Tri-Cities to accept the head coaching position at Prosser High School where he spent four seasons. Schumacher currently works at Kamiakin High School as English Teacher

He played his high school ball at Kamiakin High then played at CBC (1991) for a year before moving on to Northwest Nazarene University where he completed his playing career. At NNC, Schumacher played in three national tournaments finishing 4th, 2nd and 8th consecutively at the NAIA national tournament.

Head Coach Lane Schumacher feels fortunate to have another quality assistant in the program stating, "Todd has been an enormous help recruiting this spring, and helping us load up with the type of players we need to compete for an Eastern Region championship," he said. "He has an understanding of the type of player that it takes to make us successful, and a tremendous ability to establish rapport with these potential Hawks."

Coach Schumacher married his wife Meggen in 2003. Meggen is a Central Washington University graduate and recently graduated from the CBC nursing program. They have a son named Mason whom was born this past June.

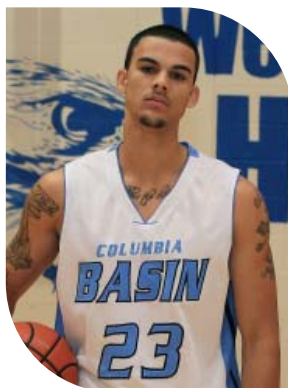

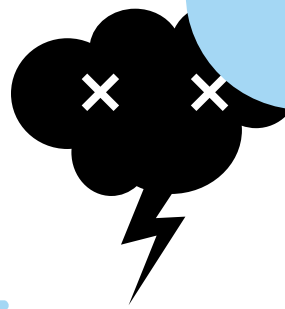
